

**2007 Nebraska State Sporting Clays Association
Annual Meeting Minutes
August, 11, 2007**

The annual meeting of the Nebraska State Sporting Clays Association pursuant to Article XII, Section 1 of its By-Laws was held August 11, 2007 at 18:45 Hrs., Central Standard Time (CST), at the One Box Gun Club. Located at HC74 Ryno Road, Broken Bow, Nebraska 68822.

Selection of the 2008 Nebraska State Sporting Clays Championship Host Club

State Delegate and Range Owner Don Albertson of Sumac Sporting Clays gave a brief discussion on 2007 State Association Shoot his club held in June. He stated attendance was good but indicated some shooters may have skipped the Association shoot to attend the Dakota Blast. Mr. Albertson was asked about an access and the possibility of poor road conditions leading to the course during the upcoming state championship. Mr. Albertson said he was working on trying to get the access road graveled.

Upon the motion of Ron Badberg with second from Kevin Bloemker it was by voice vote unaimously aproved that: **Sumac Sporting Clays of Homer, Nebraska will host the 2008 Nebraska State Sporting Clays Championship.**

Selection of the 2008 State Association Shoot Host Club

Two ClubOwners, Mr. Larry Swanson of GrandPa's Acres and Mike Burton representing Pheasant Bonanza gave presentation before the NSSCA in regards to hosting the 2008 Association shoot. After considerable and pointed discussions, a vote by paper ballot was taken and subsequently tallied.

Upon the motion of **Secretary** Pabian with second from **Treasurer** Kriz it was by ballot vote unaimously aproved that: **GrandPa's Acres of Syracuse, Nebraska would host the 2008 Nebraska State Association Shoot.**

NSCA Zone 5 Shoot - 2008 Host Club Application

Treasurer Terry Kriz spoke on behalf of the Oak Creek Sporting Clays Club in regards to their application to host the 2008 Zone 5 Shoot. Mr. Kriz gave a brief discussion about Oak Creek's proposed Zone 5 shoot program and stated the Zone shoot would take place in early Sept of 2008 (non-negotiable date as set by nationals) if Oak Creek was awarded the shoot. Treasurer Kriz also asked permission to be the 2009 - Zone 5 Host Club if their 2008 application failed.

Upon the motion of Lynn Pelan with second from Don Albertson it was by voice vote unaimously aproved that: **Oak Creek Sporting Club be allowed to apply for the 2009 Zone 5 Shoot.**

State Delegate James Beck presented a document before the NSSCA regarding the

possible establishment of a Nebraska State Zone Team and its proposed selection process.

Club Owner Diane Albertson spoke in regards to standardizing on trophies given out at the State Championship.
