

**2006 Nebraska State Sporting Clays Association
Annual Meeting Minutes
August 12, 2006**

The annual meeting of the Nebraska State Sporting Clays Association pursuant to Article XII, Section 1 of its By-Laws was held August 12, 2006 at 18:40 Hrs., Central Standard Time (CST), at the Heartland Public Shooting Park Club House. Located at 6788 Husker Hwy, Grand Island Ne. 68803

Members of the Nebraska State Sporting Clays Association (NSSCA) in attendance were. President Robin Irvine, Treasurer Terry Kriz, Directors Matt Lyne, Don Albertson, Larry Swanson, Craig Bohannon, Kent Coen, J.W. Beck and Steve Hilker.

Subsequent to the completion of the Roll Call and certifying that a quorum was present **President Robin Irvine** requested the 2006 Annual Meeting of the NSSCA be called to order.

1. ROLL CALL

NSSCA President Robin Irvine called the Roll

2. READING OF THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

3. TREASURERS REPORT

President Robin Irvine introduced Treasurer Terry Kriz and requested that he present the NSSCA Treasurer's Report. Treasurer Kriz gave his report during which he acknowledged that he had received Association dues from Larry Swanson of Grandpa's Sporting Acres and Don Albertson of Sumac Sporting Clays in addition to those listed in his summary of the NSSCA funds. With no questions to the Treasurer from the Directorate or the Executive Council a motion by **Director Matt Lynn** with the second of **President Robin Irvine**, to adopt and approve the Treasurer's Report as presented was called for and unanimously approved by voice vote.

4. REPORT OF COMMITTEES

There are no active committees at this time.

5. CORRESPONDENCE

There was no correspondence to come to the attention of the Association at this Meeting.

6. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no unfinished business on the Association agenda.

7. NEW BUSINESS

Admission of Bunker Hill to the Nebraska State Sporting Clays Association

President Robin Irvine brought forth the request that Bunker Hill (club) would like to join the NSSCA. Treasurer Terry Kriz indicated that Bunker Hill had paid their NSSCA Fee. Having met the requirements of **Article VII** of the by-laws. Treasurer Terry requested a motion to approve Bunker Hill's entry into the NSSCA. Upon the Motion of **Director Matt Lyne** with second of **Director Larry Swanson** it was by voice vote unanimously approved that: **Bunker Hill be allowed entry into the NSSCA as a Club.**

Selection of the 2007 Nebraska State Sporting Clays Championship Host Club

Upon the Motion of Treasurer Terry Kriz with second of Director Larry Swanson it was by voice vote unanimously approved that: **One Box Club of Broken Bow, Nebraska will host the 2007 Nebraska State Sporting Clays Championship.**

Fitasc and 5-Stand Events to Remain Part of the State Championship Program

The question of whether to split the State Sporting Clays Championship into 2 separate shoots (Small Bore/Preliminary/Main) and (Fitasc/5-Stand) was brought to the floor. Several Directors voiced their concern about the splitting the state shoot up citing Nebraska's membership numbers and that other States have tried with varied success. A majority of the Directors indicated that the shooters like all the events to be held at one state championship.

Upon the Motion of Director Matt Lyne with second of Treasurer Terry Kriz it was by voice vote unanimously approved the the **Fitasc and 5-Stand Events shall remain part of the Nebraska State Sporting Clays Championship format.**

High School State Shoot to be held at the previous year's State Championship Site

Upon the Motion of Treasurer Terry Kriz with second of Delegate Don Albertson it was by voice vote unanimously approved that: **The High School State Shoot shall be held at the location of the previous year State Sporting Clays Championship.**

2007 State Association Shoot

Upon the Motion of Director Matt Lyne second by Treasurer Terry Kriz it was by voice vote unanimously approved that: **Sumac Sporting Clays shall host the 2007 State Association Shoot.**

NSCA Zone 5 Shoot Application

President Robin Irvine discussed the failed attempt by the State to secure the 2006 NSCA Zone 5 Shoot. Applications to host the 2007 NSCA Zone 5 shoot must be into Nationals by August 22nd. A vote would be cast around the first week in October to determine the 2007 Host Club. A short discussion as to who could host the zone shoot followed. Upon Motion of Director Matt Lyne second by Delegate Don Albertson it was by voice vote unanimously approved that: **Oak Creek Sporting Club attempt to secure the 2007 NSCA Zone 5 shoot.**

Nebraska State Sporting Clays Association Target Fee Assessment

A discussion was brought to the floor regarding the establishment of a State target fee to be assessed on registered NSCA targets shoot at NSSCA clubs. The money collected would be used as added money to the state shoot to be split across the 7 (seven) classes evenly, (1st - 3rd / 50-30-20). Upon Motion of Treasurer Terry Kriz second by Director Matt Lyne is was by voice unanimously approved that:

As of September 1, 2006. A two cent (.02) per target fee shall be assessed on all NSCA registered targets thrown by NSSCA member clubs. The NSSCA clubs shall submit the collected funds no later than 15 days of the shoots completion to the NSSCA Treasurer. Acceptable form of payment shall be check or money order.

Western Zone Directors

No nomination ballots were returned in the Elections of the Western Zone Directors. Upon motion of **Treasurer Terry Kriz** second by **Director Craig Bohannon** it was by voice unanimously approved that:

Steve Hilker and Dave Stunkle be allowed to serve an additional term of 3 years as Western Zone Directors

Secretary Vacancy

President Robin Irvine spoke to the Association about the vacancy of NSSCA Secretary office. President Irvine explained that Mr. Chris Hendricks could no longer serve as Secretary due to time constraints. President Irvine thanked the Secretary for all the work he had done. Upon motion by **Treasurer Terry Kriz** second by **Delegate Don Albertson** it was by voice unanimously approved that:

Jeff Pabian be elected to the office of NSSCA Secretary

8. OTHER DISCUSSIONS

It was agreed by majority that a meeting would be held on September 30, 2006, 6 pm (CST) at the Heartland Public Shooting Park Club house for the purpose of scheduling the 2007 shoot dates for NSSCA clubs.

The question of the number of targets thrown in the main event format started the discussions. Several Directors expressed their opinions as to the number of targets thrown for the main event most supported a 200 target race. Other Directors acknowledged that competitors seem to like the 200 target main event, but conceded that shooting all 200 targets during one day would be a lot to ask of the competitors and of the club (cost wise). The Association agreed that it should be up to the host club to determine the format of the state shoot as they bear the risk.

Other topics of discussion were.

1. The postage and handling costs of delivering trophies after the completion of the state championship.
2. The number of rotations and squads needed for the State Championship main event.
3. Increasing the number of targets thrown for the Fitasc at the State Championship event from 50 to 100.
4. Event Dates of next years State Championship.
5. Increasing State membership with both old and young shooters via promotions (NSSF)
6. Association Recognition by NSCA.
7. NSSCA clubs sponsoring Hunter Safety Education Courses via Bill Harder.

9. ADJOURNMENT

President Robin Irvine called for the adjournment of the Annual NSSCA meeting at 21:15 Hrs.
