

**2010 Nebraska State Sporting Clays Association
Annual Meeting Minutes
August, 13, 2010**

The annual meeting of the Nebraska State Sporting Clays Association pursuant to Article XII, Section 1 of its By-Laws was held August 13, 2010 at 18:40 Hrs., Central Standard Time (CST), at the Pheasant Bonanza Sporting Club. Located in Tekemaha, Nebraska 68061.

Officers and Directors of the Nebraska State Sporting Clays Association (NSSCA), National Sporting Clays Association (NSCA) State Delegates and Range owners in attendance were. **President** James Beck, **Treasurer** Terry Kriz, **Secretary** Jeff Pabian. . **NSSCA Directors** Todd Walters, Tim Tabor, Greg Preston, Robin Irvine.

Subsequent to the completion of the Roll Call and certifying that a quorum was present, **President** James Beck requested the 2010 Annual Meeting of the NSSCA be called to order.

1. ROLL CALL

NSSCA **Secretary** Jeff Pabian called the Roll.

2. READING OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES. (May 15, 2010)

The previous meeting minutes were read aloud. A call for any corrections or amendments was silent. The minutes stood as read. A motion to by Treasurer Kriz, with second of Director Walters to approve the meeting minutes as presented was called and unanimously approved by voice vote.

3. TREASURES REPORT

President JW Beck introduced **Treasurer** Terry Kriz and requested that he present the NSSCA Treasurer's Report. **Treasurer** Kriz gave his report and with no questions asked a motion by **President** JW Beck with second by **Secretary** Jeff Pabian to adopt and approve the Treasure r's Report as presented was called and unanimously approved by voice vote.

4. REPORT OF COMMITTEES

There are no active committees at this time.

5. CORRESPONDENCE

There was no correspondence to come to the attention of the NSSCA at this time.

6. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no unfinished business before the NSSCA at this time.

7. NEW BUSINESS

State Championship Shoot Specifications

President Beck gave a presentation on the State Championship program specifications he had worked on. Several other board members commented that at other state championship's, out of state shooters are not recognized. We need to standardize our payouts and trophies.

NSSCA shall directly distribute State Championship Main Event Passes Won at the State Association Shoot.

The board brought up questions regarding state championships entry fees paid out at the state association shoot. Subsequently the NSSCA board decided to take a more active role in distributing the main event passes to the state championship.

Motion: The NSSCA shall award each class winner (M, AA, A, B, C, D, E – in or out of state) of the State Association shoot a free main event pass to the Nebraska State Championship. 1St Secretary Pabian with 2nd by Treasurer Kriz, the motion

Upon further discussion by the board a motion to Grant the 2011 Nebraska State Sporting Clays Championship to Heartland Public Shoot Park - Grand Island was made by Secretary Pabian, with 2nd by Treasurer Kriz.

A voice vote was called by Secretary **Jeff Pabian** regarding the motion and it was unanimously approved.

8. OTHER DISCUSSIONS

Fred Multulka representing Lincoln Trap and Skeet announced that LT&S was joining the NSSCA. Fred mentioned that LT&S were in the design and planning stages of building a shooting sports complex in Lincoln.

The NSSCA also thought it was best that State High School Championship remain a separate competition instead of adding them to the NE State Championship.

Tim Tabor brought up the idea of club cooperation when hosting big shoots. Clubs could pool their resources – equipment and manpower in order to lower the host clubs expense.
